Fabric equipment such as bibs or beanbags will not be used. The antibacterial wipes will be stored in staff coaching bags (provided by AVSSP) at all times.</p>	Yes
Delivery of session to pupils	AVSSP Staff members / pupils / participants	<p>Staff are advised to maintain social distance from pupils and other members of staff where possible to do so during the delivery of sports activities, following guidance updated by central government.</p> <p>Where possible we will aim to provide ventilation through opening of windows/doors/fire exits to give adequate airflow and circulation during activity sessions.</p>	Yes
Break and Lunch times	AVSSP Staff members / Young person / Participant	<p>During break and lunch time's young persons and participants are expected to wash hands before eating or drinking. No sharing of drinks or snacks to be allowed.</p> <p>Where necessary break and lunch times will be staggered to reduce the amount of young persons / participants drinking/eating together. AVSSP aim to provide a separate area for groups to use at break and lunch times.</p>	Yes
